### Griffiss Airport - Sky Dome

- A Round 7 CFA award
- One-of-a-kind, year-round indoor instrumented sUAS experimentation environment
- The indoor facility will support collaborative efforts between the Air Force Research Laboratory Information Directorate and the NY UAS Test Site
- \$800,000 additionally secured by Senator Griffo
- Local cyber companies like Assured Information Security and AX Enterprises are leading the collaborative effort as part of the largest indoor, instrumented UAV experimentation in the Nation





- ▶ Phase 3 of project began in 2015, with substantial completion in Spring 2018
- ► Leveraged \$8.6M in New York State Funding



#### AFRL Commercialization Academy & IDEA NY

IDEA NY is a one-year business accelerator program that starts after successful completion of the AFRL Commercialization Academy, and provides startups with hands-on mentorship and the possibility of winning up to \$200,000 in seed funding! \$2 million in funding was awarded by Empire State Development. Focus on Cyber Security, Big Data Analytics, Information Systems and UAS industries



To Date - 46 Startups in 4+ years 29 Licenses

- Startup teams will enter the Spring 2019 Commercialization Academy cohort
- Compete at Demo Day for \$300,000 in prize seed funding, with \$200,000 going to the overall winner and \$100,000 going to the second-place runner-up
- The teams will then participate in the year-long IDEA NY accelerator program
- Technical assistance will be provided by the Griffiss Institute, the Griffiss Institute Business Incubator, and Mohawk Valley EDGE
- Participating teams will be required to reside in the Mohawk
   Valley region for a 12-month period after Demo Day

#### Griffiss Park Landowners Association

- ▶ New Sculpture Three new pieces of sculpture were acquired in 2018 to anchor the new roundabouts on NY 825. They are "The Wings of Change," "Nature's Wrath," (both by Trumansburg artist James Seaman) and "Peripheral Center" by Brooklyn artist Osman Akan. Akan had previously created the "Nano" sculpture for Marcy Nanocenter.
- ► Trail Extension The Griffiss Nature Trail was successfully extended to the Mohawk River Trail at Chestnut Street. The extension is one of a number of amenities that GPLA capitalized this year, including an award-winning woven word sculpture along the Chestnut Street fence; numerous deciduous and evergreen plantings; and a Zagster bike share station.
- ➤ Trail improvements A Zagster bike share station was added to the Griffiss Nature Trail along Ellsworth Road. The station has six new bikes, one of which is a tandem trike for differently-abled riders. A long-term planting plan began for the trail. This year, two shade allees were planted, with more to follow in the coming years. One new piece of sculpture was leased "Chicasaw," by Isaac Witkin. The Park is already home to another Witkin, "Vermont II."
- ► Family Activities GPLA hosted three successfully movie nights on the Park, with over 250 people in attendance.

#### 2018 GLDC's Year in Review

- ▶ \$625.45 Million in CapEx since Griffiss Park was created in 1995
- ▶ \$3.3 Million in taxes generated from Griffiss Park, 7.1% of the City of Rome's total Property Tax Revenue
- ► Over 5,823 employees work at Griffiss from over 25 Counties
- ► More than **77 Businesses operate** inside Griffiss
- ► STEM wages average \$99,000 annually
- ▶ 2017 AFRL Economic Impact: \$392,305,884
- ➤ 2018 Projects: transfer Building 302 from the Air Force, leverage UAV/UAS activities into a major project, and connect Griffiss Park with the Woodhaven Redevelopment Activity
